Camp Prime Time offers families/groups that have members with special needs the enjoyment of the outdoors by offering rustic cabins a main lodge, hot showers and restrooms at no cost to the visitors. The camp consists of a main lodge, 14 cabins, and two bathroom facilities. Sleeping capacity is approximately 100 campers. Groups generally stay from Friday evening through Sunday afternoon. All food and meal preparation is provided by highly qualified volunteers. With some prior arrangements, individual dietary needs can be met. Parents are responsible for supervision and medical care of their own children.
